





SBC Roof Series: Metal Roof Installation

- 5. **Ridge and Eave Closure Installation:** These components are installed to finish and seal off the top (ridge) and bottom (eaves) edges of the metal roof, providing a neat, finished appearance and preventing water ingress.
- 6. **Trim and Edging Installation:** Metal trim and edging components are applied to cover and protect the edges of the metal panels, creating a clean, finished look while providing added weather protection.
- 7. **Quality Check and Clean Up:** After the metal roof installation is complete, the installation crew conducts a thorough quality check to ensure that all components are properly installed and that the roof is watertight. Any debris or waste from the installation process is then cleaned up and removed from the work site.
